Three Tall Pines is an award winning quartet—playing bluegrass and Americana from the heart of New England. The group's timeless originals and interpretations of traditional songs persuade listeners that bygone eras were just a short while ago. Impressive instrumentalists and songwriters in their own right, they transcend their diverse musical backgrounds to achieve soulful harmonies and sensitive performances that draw audiences in and leave plenty of space for the story to shine through.

Their 2008 album 'Short While Ago,' recorded at Signature Sounds brought both critical acclaim and national exposure to the band. The band released their second album, 'All That's Left' in 2012. Recorded at the Hi n Dry

Studios in Somerville, MA this album was lauded for its original, hand crafted songs. Three Tall Pines founding members, Dan Bourdeau and Joe Lurgio, met in 2008 and quickly became musical collaborators known as strong vocalists and songwriters. Bourdeau and Lurgio provide the band with raw material; carefully crafted original songs. Band members Conor Smith and Nick DiSebastian, both virtuosic musicians, help to shape each tune, enhancing and embellishing each song's story and message. Bourdeau's timeless lyrics, Lurgio's melodies and brilliant mandolin tone, Smith's colorful and driving fiddle, and DiSebastian's powerful rhythm and stylistic versatility all serve to enrich each heartfelt melody combining to make pure, heartfelt, good music.
